STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) FOR E-CHALLAN SYSTEM

PREFACE:

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has issued amendments in Rule 139 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules vide its Notification bearing No. G.S.R. 1081(E) dated the 2nd November-2018, also vide Notification No. G.S.R. & 584(E) dated 25th-September 2020 by incorporating Rule 139-A and Rule 167 and Notification No. G.S.R. 575(E) dated 11th August-2021 by incorporating Rule 167-A of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, authorizing any Police Officer in uniform or any other officer, authorized by the State Government in this behalf to issue a challan through system of e-challan facility in physical or electronic form, to a person acting in violation of the provisions of the M.V. Act and seizure of documents produced in electronic form. It has been considered to prescribe a Standing Operating Procedure (SOP) for the same so as to implementation of e-challan in true spirit.

In order to promote e-Governance, JK Traffic Police has implemented the e-Challan system, which is a Pan-India project developed by NIC that provides a number of user-friendly features, covering all major functionalities of Traffic Enforcement System ie; issuance of Traffic e-Challan, on spot cashless payment, access to previous records, integration with Digi locker and M-parivahan apps using Hand Held device.

INTRODUCTION:

e-Challan system is a comprehensive digital solution for Traffic Enforcement System delivered through an Android based mobile app and a web portal. e- Challan is an end-to-end digital enforcement solution integrated with Vahan and Sarathi applications (Database) of MoRTH. It has got two basic components.

- 1. **Web Portal:** Multi-functional web application for use of the enforcement/police officials, Courts, RTOs, Higher officials, transporters, citizens etc.
- 2. Mobile App: For on-road challaning/disposal related activity to be carried out by enforcement/police officials.

SALIENT FEATURES OF E-CHALLAN SYSTEM:

e-Challan Mobile App and Web portal provide a sophisticated, holistic traffic enforcement solution for Transport Enforcement wing and Traffic Police Departments with a nationwide common database of offences and challans. These are also integrated with courts. This integrated traffic enforcement solution has been designed primarily for the Transport Wing and Traffic Police. It is an Android-based mobile app with convenience of online payment of challans, "anytime and anywhere" for the citizens.

Management of traffic violations through multiple devices such as Smart PoS, CCTV and speed guns is possible. There is Seamless integration with National Databases like Vahan and Sarathi to book online and offline challans. No duplicate or fake challans (comprehensive monitoring, audit option for each individual challan or concerned official by department remotely) could be possible. Blockage of transactions on concerned vehicle/licence can be done, in case of pending challan.

WEB PORTAL MODULE:

The concept of e-Challan Web Portal is divided in two parts:

- e-Challan application for Manual/device challans.
- · e-Challan application for postal challans.

e-Challan application is integrated online on a real time basis with the database of VAHAN for Vehicles and SARATHI for Driving Licenses. The system provides accuracy along with a pleasant interface, makes the present manual system more interactive, speedy and user friendly. The transaction reports can be retrieved from the system as and when required. Thus, there is no delay in the availability of any information, whatever needed, which can be captured very quickly and easily.

The salient features of the application are as follows:

A web-based interface for consolidated over-view of the system using MIS and dashboard features. Additional functionalities like e-payment for services, alerts through SMS. Connecting all the stakeholders (Enforcement agency, Registration/Licensing Authority, Judiciary) through a common system to ensure data integrity, sharing, reliability and transparency. End-to-end automation of the process while enabling efficiency for all users.

MOBILE APP (POS) MODULE:

The application introduces a novel concept of using mobile based app for issuing Traffic Challan. The mobile based access ensures the services are available anytime anywhere. This application is a built-in-facility update data

from/to national vehicle and driver databases. End-to-end automation of the process minimizes bad practices thereby enabling efficiency at each level of users. The prominent highlights of the app are as:

100% digitization and documentation of records help in improving the visibility on offenders, types of offences frequently committed, payments received on time etc. Detailed data access of Vahan - Sarathi data to all authentic e-Challan user. Onsite payment through credit/debit card and online payment through IPG.

OBJECTIVE:

The main objective of e-Challan System is to enhance and upgrade the existing system of enforcement of traffic rules by increasing its efficiency and effectiveness.

e-Challan system is aimed to improve the working scenario by replacing the existing manual system with the web/application-based interface which provides the features of Challan entry, Challan Dispatch to Court (Court referral), payment of challans, creation of reports and complete management at user end. The system aims to provide a perfect solution for the current challenges which the Police department is facing with respect to tracking challan records, payments, reports, etc. by leveraging latest technologies which are easy to use, adapt and implement at the ground level. It is an initiative of the Govt. of India and aims at improving service access and transparency in the system.

BENEFITS OF E-CHALLAN SYSTEM:

Benefits of adopting e-challan are:

- Enforcement agencies need not physically handle any document.
- Office need not maintain any inventory or record.
- No harassment for citizens to collect document after the payment of compounding fees as the challan when disposed would automatically update the record in the Database.
- Real time offence status is available to the transport and traffic enforcement officers and to the citizens.
- · Fast, transparent and accountable system.

 e-Challan System enhances the visibility of offenders and better traffic management, issuing challans through personal contact, which is when a policeman catches a violator and issues a challan and the other is through non-contact

An integrated e-Challan system is expected to bring in more transparency in the prosecution of vehicles violating the Motor Vehicles Act. As soon as an e-Challan is issued, the owner of the vehicle will get SMS. The e Challan is especially intended to catch repeat offenders, who are liable to pay higher fines.

e-Challan devices are synced with the central database of the Transport Department and will immediately identify an offender, who will be issued an on-the-spot fine. The e-Challan device has a portable printer for immediate issuance of e-Challans. It also has an attached portable camera to take a picture of errant drivers and vehicles and send them to the central database. The major benefit of these smart e-Challan devices is identification and prosecuting repeat offenders, on whom heavier penalties will be imposed. Also, traffic officers would be able to easily identify antecedents of a vehicle owner by entering the registration number in the device and it would become easy to find out if the vehicle concerned was ever involved in a similar incident in the past.

With this technology, the traffic officer can manage to save their valuable time and focus on the traffic situation. The paperless system helps personnel for speedy challans. This new e-Challan system will bring transparency as well as bring down the instances of conflict between traffic police and violators. This system also intends to lessen the manpower required for charging traffic violators.

The features available through e-Challan system are highlighted below.

- · Add document evidence (impounded).
- · Add witness details.
- · Add remarks.
- Auto generated Category for Vehicle class.
- · Multiple options for data input.
- · Online search from database Vahan for Vehicle & Sarathi for DL.
- · Multiple Challan Accused Option.
- · Owner.
- o Driver.
- Owner & Driver.
- Automatic Address Identification.
- Geo-tagging of Challan Spot.
- View option for RC/DL details with offence history.
- Daily summery report over mobile app.
- · State-specific configuration option.

e-Challan Web Application:

- Comprehensive and informative Dashboard.
- MIS, Reports, Analytics.
- Easily searchable Challan history.
- Filter option on multiple parameters.
- User/Role/Master management.
- Offence management Tools.
- Challan Investigation, disposal, Court Dispatch (Court referral).
- Release of Impounded vehicles.
- Citizen Corner on e-Challan portal to generate/view challan online.
- Display Challan with actual location.
- History management for whole activities over web e-Challan.
- Online/Cash Payment Option.
- Configurable receipt, Vehicle disposal and challan prints etc.
- Role/Privilege based access transferable by Admin.

HARDWARE:

The model of e-Challan System is dependent on infrastructure provided for the project. The following hardware has been provided to office and field staff for comprehensive implementation of e-Challan System:

Hardware for Office staff:

05 nos. of Computer systems of latest specifications to 05 Traffic Units in JK.

Hardware for Field staff:

411 Handheld Devices have been provided by JK Bank. Further, JK Bank shall supply more numbers of Handheld e-Challan Devices /POS Machine with paper rolls for printing and maintenance of these machines, as per requirement from time to time.

CONNECTIVITY:

An interface with feature of Android based mobile app and a web portal is the base of e-Challaning System. Both applications are integrated online on a real time basis with the database of VAHAN for Vehicles and SARATHI for Driving Licenses. For proper link between mobile app and web portal, connectivity has been ensured with the following modes:

- Pre activated data enabled SIM Cards have been installed in each Handh eld Device provided by JK Bank.
- Internet connectivity required at DDO level is arranged locally so far.
 However, Fiber Optic Connectivity of maximum 100 mbps is required for smooth functioning at UNIT Level.

TRAINING:

Regular training is being imparted for usage of Handheld Devices to Challaning Officials of JK Traffic Police. So far more than 100 training sessions have been organized and more than 400 officials have been trained in handling POS devices and at unit level e-challan section staff has also been trained to handle backend operations. This should be a regular affair at TPO.

WORKING STRUCTURE OF E-CHALLAN SYSTEM:

A detailed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for validation of Driving License, Registration Certificate and other transport related documents/presented in electronic from through IT or mobile app platform has been issued by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, GOI (copy annexed).

E-Challan App for Handheld Device:

- Handheld devices received from JK bank are given to units and further distributed to all challaning officers.
- Login ID for each challaning officer is prepared by I/C Challaning Branch. Each challaning officer is allocated a user ID and password.
- Challaning offices shall login to the e-Challan app using their user ID and password.
- For issuance of a new challan, after login the challaning officer shall open "New challans".
- Challaning officers have the option to fetch detail (Vehicle or Driving License) Online or otherwise feed the detail manually via Keypad.
- Challaning officers shall insert smart card Registration Certificate in Card Slot to fetch vehicle detail using Smart card option, and if not then use online option. (Smart card chip does not contain complete vehicle details, hence vehicle details have to be obtained from, both options ie; Smart Card & Online).
- Challan address shall be auto generated through GPS by the App (this is optional and auto generated).
- · Travel details of the violator may be fed manually. This field is optional.
- Violator Type has to be selected from the given options ie; 1. Owner 2. Driver & 3. Owner and Driver as per the situation.
- In case violator shows Driving License in Digi locker or m-Parivahan App, then challaning officer shall fetch Driving License detail.
- Detail of Violator shall be auto generated as per challaning officer selection of violator type.

- Challaning officers shall mandatorily enter contact number of the violator/owner on-the-spot in the e-Challan app.
- Offences shall be selected from drop down using pre-fed offence list.
- Challaning officers have the option to Impound Vehicle or Impound Document as per the situation. Both options can be fed using drop down selection.
- Challaning officers have the facility to capture picture of Impounded Vehicle or Impounded Document using camera of the Handheld Device.
 The captured picture will be auto fetched in the challan detail.
- Challaning officers also have an option to add witness or remarks. Both options can be entered using drop down selection.
- On completion of new challan, option of submit challan shall appear.
- On selecting submit, complete challan will appear on the screen with the option to confirm or cancel. In case of any correction, Challaning officer will select cancel option and make necessary corrections. In case, challan is found correct, then Challaning Officer will click confirm. Once confirmed by Challaning Officer, challan shall be submitted.

On selecting confirmation, the app will reflect the following three modes of challan disposal:

- a. With Cash /Card payment at the Spot for issuance of challan with acceptance of compounding payment through Cash or Debit/Credit Card. The steps for the same are:
- 1. Select option of 'with payment'.
- Payment option will appear ie; by Cash or card. Select 'by card' then OK.
- 3. Payment detail will appear containing challan no. and fine amount. Select OK.
- 4. Card payment option appears that indicate please swipe or insert or tap the card.
- 5. After successful transaction process, challan format will appear on the screen with the option of thermal printer. Since challan is already disposed-off on-the-spot, if violator needs copy of the challan, then copy will be provided to the violator.

6. After above process, click on submit. Then option of click picture of receipt will appear with sign of camera. If required, click the picture otherwise submit without picture.

Then challan will appear on dashboard of POS showing pending status Select the challan and upload the same to get it uploaded on e-Challan server.

Note: In case, when fine payment is accepted successfully, then there is no need to confiscate documents ie; RC/DL on-the-spot and violator should be allowed to go thereafter.

- b. Without payment on the spot: for issuance of challan without compounding payment on-the-spot. The steps for the same are:
- 1. Select option of without payment challan.
- 2. Challan format will appear on the screen with the option of thermal printer.
- 3. Take two thermal prints of challans ie; one for violator and one for office.
- 4. Hand over one copy to violator which shall be signed by challaning Officer at designated place and official copy will be got signed from violator at designated place.
- 5. After above process, click on submit. Then option of click picture of seized document/impounded vehicle will appear with sign of camera. If required, click the picture otherwise submit without picture.
- 6. Then challan will appear on dashboard showing pending status
- 7. Select the challan and upload the same on e-challan server.
- 8. Violator can pay the penalty or the compounding amount on-line through IPG within sixty days (60) from the date of issuing of chalan, in case of failure to pay the fine amount within the stipulated period, the challan shall be forwarded to virtual court for disposal

Note: In case, when challan is kept pending, then the acceptance of both documents in virtual form ie; RC/DL is not feasible on-the-spot. Hence, one original document either RC or DL needs to be taken into possession otherwise vehicle shall have to be impounded to ensure disposal of challan and violator should be allowed to go thereafter.

- c. Sent to Court: For non-compoundable offences on-the-spot, sent to court option is applicable. Select option of sent to court. Then option of Court Selection appears below.
- 1. Select name of the concerned Court along with hearing date and time. Hearing date will be selected next working day and allocate time 10.00 AM as in routine.
- 2. Pop-up of confirmation with Challan Pending Mode will appear Select Yes and app will proceed further.
- 3. Challan format will appear on the screen with the option of thermal printer.
- 4. Take two thermal prints of the challan ie; one for violator.
- 5. Hand over one copy to violator, which shall be signed by the Challaning Officer at the designated place and the official copy will be got signed from the violator at the designated place.
- 6. After above process, click on submit. Then option of click picture of seized document/impounded vehicle will appear with sign of camera. If required, click the picture otherwise submit without picture.
- 7. Then challan will appear on dashboard showing pending status.
- 8. Select the challan and upload the same to get it uploaded on e-Challan server.

Note: Being a Non-Compoundable offence, fine shall be decided by the court. Hence, on-the-spot disposal is not applicable. As the Challan is kept pending, the acceptance of both documents in virtual form ie; RC/DL is not feasible on-the-spot. Hence, one original document either RC or DL needs to be taken into possession otherwise vehicle shall be impounded to ensure prosecution proceeding in Court and violator should be allowed to go thereafter.

Payment of Compounding Fees:

Compounding fees shall be accepted online on e-challan URL. The concept of e-Challaning is helpful in providing new modes of payment to violators. In this mode, latest facilities are available to streamline the process of payment. Hence, all the potential payment modes are available to the citizens.

The following modes of payment are available through e-Challan system:

- 1. On-the-spot payment of traffic challan through Handheld e-Challan Device using a payment aggregation with option of payment through cash & all types of Debit/Credit Card.
- 2. Online payment through Payment Gateway. Violator can also pay the penalty or the compounding amount on-line through IPG within sixty days (60) from the date of issuing of challan. In case of failure to pay the fine amount within the stipulated period, the challan shall be forwarded to virtual court for disposal.

Seizure of documents produced in electronic form:

- I. In cases where there is an offence made out necessitating seizure of any documents, and such documents are produced in electronic form in accordance with rule (1) of rule 139(1), their seizure by the challaning officer shall be made electronically on the portal.
- II. Details of the seized documents shall be recorded chronologically in the relevant portal and such record shall be reflected on a regular basis on the portal.
- III. Upon seizing any document, the date and time stamp of seizure and identity of the challaning officer, shall issue a receipt acknowledging such seizure, in physical or electronic form.
- IV. Upon seizing any documents, the date and time stamp of seizure and identity of the challaning officer shall be recorded on the portal.

Online recommendation for suspension;

- I. The Driving License or the Certificate of Registration can be recommended for suspension/blocking by the competent enforcement officer.
- II. This recommendation will be reflected in the home page of the competent officer ie; the Licensing Authority/Regional Transport Authority page on real time basis and based on law, further decision for suspension/blocking can be taken.

This will reflect in all e-challan app implemented across all States/UTs enforcement officer's device in real time. Based on the information they can take suitable action as enshrined in Law.

ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Role and Responsibilities of SSP Traffic / District Admn.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure that regular training shall be imparted for usage of Handheld Devices /POS from their respective echallan sections where the manpower is already trained to train all personnel of Traffic Police. In addition, Training Sessions will also be conducted at THQ JK level.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure that whenever a new Challaning Officer posted in Traffic Wing, he/she is provided training in use of these POS devices before being deputed in the field.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure mechanism for the resolution
 of double payment/failed online/hand held device transactions and
 ensure refund of excess amount collected either through online or
 handheld device to the concerned in a time bound manner.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall establish a Grievance Redressal Cell at their respective Hqrs. which shall be functional six (6) days a week and devise a proper mechanism for the resolution of e-challaning grievances in a time bound manner. On line grievance should also be treated that way. Mail IDs for grievance redressal should be given wide publicity. Maximum time limit for the redressal of grievance should not exceed 15 days.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure that the following reports shall be created and perused on a regular basis:
 - o Daily challan and cash report.
 - o Weekly DL Seizure/Acknowledgement report
 - o Fortnightly MIS report (collection traction and reconcile report)
 - Monthly report of excess amount refund in respect of multiple payment.
 - o Monthly GOs challan report.
 - Quarterly suspension recommendation of DL report as per format issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety.
- SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure that driving license is seized in all applicable cases as per M.V. Act, 1988 as amended in 2019 and as per the instructions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety.

 SSP Traffic/ District Admin shall ensure that e-challan cell/section to run e-challan system for smooth functioning and training / configuration and maintenance of relevant e-challan records.

2. Role and Responsibilities of DySP /Traffic (Circle Admin):

- DySP Traffic, shall ensure that a motor vehicle shall only be stopped by Challaning Officer on the commission of visible traffic offence. A motor vehicle can be stopped for checking of documents or search of vehicle only under the specific instructions of senior supervisory officers.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that Challaning officers shall properly use hand held devices. In case of any negligent damage / mishandling/ lose/theft of Handheld Device, strict departmental action shall be taken against erring officer/official. Further, Zonal DySP Traffic shall immediately intimate the same to SSP Traffic and also get the device blocked.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that Challaning officers shall accept RC/DL/PUC/Insurance, etc. documents shown by violators through digital format ie; Digilocker/m-Parivahan app.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that in order to prevent habitual violators from endangering other road users and if a violator is having three or more pending e- Challans against that vehicle, then that vehicle shall be impounded by the Challaning officer till the vehicle owner/driver clears all pending challans in larger public interest.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that Challaning officer shall keep the keypad
 of the Handheld Device towards card holder while he/she is entering pin
 no. for accepting card payment.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that the behavior of all police officials deployed in their respective zone shall be polite yet firm and they shall not succumb to any extraneous consideration.
- DySP Traffic shall ensure that if Challaning officer informs regarding any fake/forged/unauthorized copy of document or impersonation by the violator, then legal action shall be taken against the violator as per law through local police.

3. Role & Responsibilities of Challaning Officers (DTI and SO):

- Challaning Officer shall stop a motor vehicle only on the commission of a visible traffic offence. A motor vehicle can however be stopped for checking of documents or search of vehicle only under the specific instructions of senior supervisory officers.
- Challaning officers shall get e-Challan Handheld Devices (POS) issued to them however, also keep a Manual Challan Book with them as well and only use manual challan book in exigency and should have plausible reason for issuing manual challan, which should be endorsed by the concerned SSP.
- Challaning officers shall undergo mandatory training regarding issuance of traffic challan/acceptance of payment though Handheld e-Challan devices.
- Challaning officers shall ensure that they shall be well conversant in use
 of handheld device and e-Challan mobile app.
- Challaning officers shall be responsible for proper handling of the handheld devices. In case of any negligent damage/ mishandling/ lose/theft of Handheld Device, strict departmental action shall be taken against erring officer/official.
- Challaning officers shall be responsible for successful transaction of on-the-spot challan. In case of any error or discrepancy during transaction, the same shall be brought to the notice of the e-Challan Cell immediately.
- Challaning officers shall immediately report any instance of damage/ theft /loss/ misplacement of Handheld e-Challan Device to their respective supervisory officers.
- Challaning officers shall ensure that their behaviour shall be polite yet firm and they shall not succumb to any extraneous consideration. Further, they shall ensure that minimum inconvenience is caused to the general public.
- Challaning officers shall mandatorily enter contact number of the violator on- the-spot in the e-Challan application in case the number is not fetched by the app while downloading online info about RC/DL.
- Challaning officers shall accept RC/DL/PUC/Insurance, etc.

documents shown by violators through digital format.

 Challaning officer should ensure that body worn camera is functional while issuing challan. In a challaning team, at least one officer / official should be wearing Body Worn Camera while issuing challan.

4. Role & Responsibilities of Challaning Branch / Section in TPO:

- E-Challan cell shall ensure handling of E-Challan hand held device inventory ie; issuance/receiving/storage.
- E-Challan Cell shall impart training of e-Challan app, Digilocker/mParivahan Apps to field staff, static staff in coordination with NIC and JK Bank (for payment).
- E-Challan Cell shall ensure upkeep of e-Challan handheld device accessories ie; printer role, SIM Card, etc. in close coordination with JK bank POS provider Branch.
- E-Challan Cell shall coordinate with NIC, and JK Bank regarding proper functioning of e-Challan system.
- E-Challan cell shall ensure that whenever a new Challaning Officer posted in Traffic Wing from other units, he/she will be imparted training regarding use of Handheld Device before being deputed in the field.
- E-Challan Cell shall immediately attend and assist the field staff in case any difficulty is found in e-Challan handheld device on-the-spot while issuing traffic challan without delay.
- E-Challan Cell shall provide/amend all necessary details/information to be displayed in Web portal & Mobile App.
- E-Challan Cell shall coordinate with NIC for implementation of m-Parivahan app for reporting traffic violations.
- E-Challan Cell shall utilize the e-Challan local web application prepared by NIC for generation of various types of reports and data analysis on regular basis.
- E-Challan Cell/ Branch shall ensure that official correspondence is not shared with the public person in any way such as vehicle release order, release documents, etc.

- E-Challan Cell /Branch shall assist the internal/external auditors regarding conducting audit of Challaning Branch.
- E-Challan Cell /Branch /Cashier shall ensure reconciliation of funds collected during the day through cash counter, online transactions and through on-the-spot challan payment using Handheld Device with JK Bank.
- The amount deposited by e-challaning officers at JK bank branches and a copy thereof shall be maintained by e-challan section and reconciled with JK bank at regular intervals.
- E-Challan Cell /Branch /Cashier shall generate MIS reports (collection transaction) and reconcile/cross check the same on a daily basis.
- E-Challan Cell /Branch /Cashier shall ensure that weekly paid challans and cash collection report shall be prepared.
- E-Challan Cell / Branch / Cashiershall ensure necessary reconciliation of accounts/ transactions on daily/ weekly/ monthly basis and shall also be responsible for verification/submission and approval of MIS reports in coordination with JK BANK, and NIC as and when required.
 - # The above SOPs shall be read with the SOPs issued by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways dated 17th of December-2018, which is annexed as Annexure "A".
 - # Motor vehicle offence list is also enclosed as Annexure "B".

In addition to above SOP, the necessary instructions and additional directions during the future course of updating or as and when feasible shall be issued from THQ.

Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for validation of Driving Licence, Registration Certificate and other transport related documents/ information presented in Electronic form thorough IT or mobile app platform

Introduction:

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways has issued an amendment in Rule 139 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules vide its Notification bearing No. G.S.R. 1081(E) dated the 2nd November 2018, enabling production of requisite documents such as certificate of registration, insurance, fitness and permit, the driving licence, certificate for pollution under check and any other relevant documents in electronic form with a view to ease of living for the people. It has been considered necessary to prescribe a Standing Operating Procedure (SOP) for the same so as to ensure its seamless implementation.

- Legal Provisions under the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and the Information Technology Act, 2000
- (i) As per recent amendment dated 2nd Nov 2018 of Rule 139 of the CMVR, 1989 Production of licence and certificate of registration -

'The driver or a conductor of a motor vehicle shall produce certificates in physical or <u>electronic form</u> certificate of registration, insurance, fitness and permit, the driving licence, certificate for pollution under check and any other relevant documents on demand by any police officer in uniform or any other officer authorised by the State Government in this behalf, and if any or all of the documents are not in his possession, he shall produce in person an extract or extracts of the documents duly attested by any police officer or by any other officer or send it to the officer who demanded the documents by registered post within 15 days from the date of demand'.

(ii) As per section 4 of the IT Act 2000 i.e. Legal recognition of electronic records-

'Where any law provides that information or any other matter shall be in writing or in the typewritten or printed form, then, notwithstanding anything contained in such law, such requirement shall be deemed to have been satisfied if such information or mater is - (a) rendered or made available in an electronic form; and (b) accessible so as to be usable for a subsequent reference'.

(iii) Further, 'electronic form' has been defined in Section 2 (r) of the IT Act 2000 as:

"electronic form" with reference to information, means any information generated, sent, received or stored in media, magnetic, optical, computer memory, micro film, computer generated micro fiche or similar device.

Clarifications:

(i) As per the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988, and the Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989, the owner/ driver has to produce the documents to the authority on



demand.

- (ii) The data related to the insurance of new vehicles and renewal of insurance of vehicles is being uploaded by the Insurance Information Board (IIB) on the VAHAN database on a daily basis now and the validity of the insurance is reflected on the mParivahan/eChallan app.
- (iii) The mParivahan mobile app is being provided by this Ministry through NIC. The Driving Licence, Registration certificate, Fitness validity, Insurance validity, Permit validity of the citizen are available on real time basis on this mobile app by entering the Driving Licence Number in case of the Driving Licence details or the Registration Number for Details pertaining to the vehicles.
- (iv) mParivahan is available to each citizen and eChallan to only enforcement officers from the Transport Department or the Police Department.
- (v) The DigiLocker platform of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, has the facility to pull a citizen's Driving Licence or the Certificate of Registration details from VAHAN and make it available in the Digilocker App in an electronic form.
- (vi) These electronic records available on DigiLocker or mParivahan are deemed to be legally recognised at par with the original documents as per the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000.
- (vii) If the online virtual copy of DL/RC (along with QR Code) or any other updated validity status (like Insurance, Tax, Permit, PUC etc.) is not available on mParivahan or DigiLocker app carried by the user, then the relevant paper documents will be required to be carried.
- Standard operating Procedure (SoP) for validating information or impounding the document(s) in Electronic Form by the enforcement agencies:
- 4.1 Validation of documents produced in an Electronic form:
- (i) The citizens can produce the documents or other information either through the Digilocker app or the mParivahan app.
- (ii) The citizen can download the Driving Licence or the Certificate of Registration through these apps and store on their mobile devices.
- (iii) The Citizen can also show particulars relating to the Driving Licence or the Vehicle through the mParivahan app on the mobile through the Internet Connectivity.
- (iv) In eChallan app facility, two modes of login credentials have been made available to the enforcement officers. The login authentication is decided by the concerned

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competent authority in the State Government/ UT Administration.

- (a) In one mode, only limited privilege of on-line verification of vehicle / license status and also off-line verification of mParivahan QR Code are available. Transport Enforcement/ Traffic Police officer can use normal android mobile apps for this purpose. This is irrespective of whether the state has implemented Vahan/ Sarathi or not, provided the data from these states are regularly updated in the National Register.
- (b) In the other mode, the officer can carry out complete challaning operation including tagging of the Driving Licence or the Certificate of Registration for impounding or suspension.
- (v) The Enforcement officer can enter the details of driving licence (DL) or the Certificate of Registration (RC) in their eChallan or mParivahan application to validate the information provided for the Driving Licence, Certificate of Registration, Fitness, Insurance, Tax etc. This would be done on an online basis using the Internet.
- (vi) The Enforcement officer can scan the QR code of the documents produced through the Digilocker based app by scanning through the QR code scanner in the Digilocker app to verify the document. The QR code in Digilocker document is encrypted and can be validated only by Digilocker app. Internet connectivity is not required for scanning the QR code and validating the documents.
- (vii) The Enforcement officer can scan the QR code of the documents produced through the mParivahan based app by scanning through the QR code scanner in the eChallan app to verify the document. The QR code in mParivahan base document is encrypted and can be validated only by eChallan app. This is an additional security feature provided by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. Internet connectivity is not required for scanning the QR code and validating the documents.
- (viii) If the vehicle registration details on the mParivahan / eChallan app contain the date of the validity of the insurance policy, fitness, tax etc. which is in-force then the requirement of a physical copy of the insurance certificate or other such document is not required.
- (ix) There would be no requirement of seizure / impounding of the documents in cases where there is no traffic related violation but validation of information can be ensured through mParivahan or eChallan or Digilocker.



4.2 The process flow under the eChallan app for generating challan and further action:

- (i) In cases where there is an offence made out necessitating seizure/ impounding of such documents in available electronic form, the States have been provided with the facility to make appropriate updation in VAHAN/ SARATHI database, on an on-line basis, against the Driving Licence or the Vehicle Registration details through eChallan system of this Ministry.
- (ii) In cases where the States are using any other database or web/mobile utility of their own, then they need to update the VAHAN/ SARATHI database through a weblink.

4.3 Generating Challans for violations:

The competent authority should have provided the authorisation in the eChallan app for the facility to the concerned enforcement officer to make a challan.

- (i) When an offence is made out against the citizen, the enforcement officer can create a challan using an on-line Point of Sale (PoS) or CCTV eChallan facility. An option to create a challan using the real-time database of VAHAN and SARATHI has been provided.
- (ii) After creating a challan, offence history will get registered in the database in VAHAN for the vehicle and SARATHI for the driver respectively.
- (iii) All offence data is available in real time online basis and easily available to the enforcement officers throughout the country.
- (iv) Enhanced penalties for repeat violations is reflected and the action against the violator can be initiated accordingly as the past offence history is available to the enforcement officers through the database.
- (v) Violator can pay the penalty or the compounding amount on-line and the citizens need not worry for physical document collection. After the payment or compounding, the case is disposed and data reflected in the Database.
- (vi) If a challan is pending or has not been disposed, then all transactions involving the vehicle i.e. NOC, Fitness, Tax etc. and for the Driving License i.e. the renewal, address change etc. are not permitted and are reflected to the traffic enforcement agencies across India.
- (vii) The violators are required to compound and close pending cases as early as possible to start or avail services like tax payment, NOC, fitness etc.



4.4 Online recommendation for suspension

- (i) The Driving Licence or the Certificate of Registration can be recommended for suspension/ blocking by the competent enforcement officer.
- (ii) This recommendation will be reflected in the home page of the competent officer i.e. the Licensing Authority/ Regional Transport Authority page on real time basis and based on law, further decision for suspension/ blocking can be taken.
- (iii) This will reflect in all echallan app implemented across all States/ UTs enforcement officer's device in real time. Based on the information they can take suitable action as enshrined in Law.
- 5. Benefits of adopting eChallan:
- (i) Enforcement agencies need not physically handle any document.
- (ii) Office need not maintain any inventory or record.
- (iii) No harassment for citizens to collect document after the payment of compounding fees as the challan when disposed would automatically update the record in the Database.
- (iv) Real time offence status is available to the transport and traffic enforcement officers and to the citizens.
- (v) Fast, transparent and accountable system.

Madam/Sir,

This Ministry has received a number of Grievances/RTI applications where the citizens have raised the issue that the documents available in DigiLocker or the mParivahan app of this Ministry are not considered valid by the traffic police or the motor vehicles department, when asked to produce.

- 2. The DigiLocker platform of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India and the mParivahan mobile app of this Ministry has the facility to pull a citizen's Driving Licence or the Registration Certificate or any other certificate in an electronic form. These electronic records available on DigiLocker or mParivahan are deemed to be legally recognised at par with the original documents as per the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000.
- 3. As per the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988, and the Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989, the owner / driver has to produce the documents viz. licence or certificate of registration etc. to the authority on demand.
- 4. The data related to the insurance of new vehicles and renewal of insurance of vehicles is also being uploaded by the Insurance Information Board (IIB) on the VAHAN database on a daily basis now and the same is reflected on the mParivahan / eChallan app of the Ministry. If the vehicle registration details on the mParivahan / eChallan app contain the details of the policy which is in-force, then the requirement of a physical copy of the insurance certificate is also not to be enforced.
- 5. In light of the provisions of the Information Technology Act 2000, it is requested to consider the documents available in the 'electronic form' in the DigiLocker platform

or the mParivahan mobile app as valid under the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and be treated at par with the certificates issued by the transport authorities.

- 6. In cases where there is an offence made out and that there is a requirement of the documents to be impounded, the enforcement agencies can have such impounding reflected in the VAHAN / SARATHI database electronically through the 'eChallan' system. There would be no requirement of physical seizure of the such documents.
- 7. If any State is using any such online enforcement solution through alternative database, then the State shall transfer the relevant information electronically through web service of VAHAN / SARATHI database.
- 8. This IT based online verification of certificates would also help the enforcement authority in ensuring the genuineness of the details which further would result in better compliance and effective monitoring.
- This will be a step under the Digital India programme with a vision to transform
 India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

G.S.R. 575(E).—Whereas the draft rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, were published, as required under sub-section (1) of section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), vide notification of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Government of India, numbered G.S.R. 136 (E), dated the 25th February, 2021 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-II, Section 3, Sub-section (i), inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby before the expiry of the period of thirty days from the date on which copies of the Gazette containing the said notification were made available to public;

And, whereas, copies of the said Gazette notification were made available to the public on the 25th February, 2021;

And, whereas, the objections and suggestions received from the public in respect of the said draft rules have been considered by the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 136A read with section 137 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, namely:—

- Short Title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (Seventeenth Amendment) Rules, 2021
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
 - 2. In Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989, after rule 167, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-
- "167A. Electronic Monitoring and Enforcement of Road Safety.-(1) The electronic enforcement device used for issuance of a challan shall have an approval certificate signed by a designated authority of the State Government certifying that the device is accurate and operating properly and the approval certificate shall be renewed on a yearly basis.

Explanation.- (1) For the purpose of this rule, "electronic enforcement device" means a speed camera, closed-circuit television camera, speed gun, body wearable camera, dashboard camera, Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR), weigh in machine (WIM) and any such other technology specified by the State Government.

- (2) Body wearable camera may be worn by police officer, transport official or any other official authorised by the State Government and such officer or official shall notify to the offender that he is being recorded by the body camera and similarly, dashboard camera may be placed on the dashboard of any police vehicle or in any other vehicle as authorised by the State Government for enforcing the traffic rules and such officer or official shall notify to the offender that he is being recorded by the dashboard camera.
- (2) State Governments shall ensure that appropriate electronic enforcement devices are placed at high-risk and high-density corridors on National Highways and State Highways, and at critical junctions at least in major cities with more than one million population (as per data available based on Million Plus Urban Agglomerations or Cities:

census of India 2011 or as per the latest census) including the 132 cities as specified in the table below, and the electronic enforcement device shall be placed in such a manner so as not to cause any obstruction, line-of-sight issues or interruption in traffic flow—

- (3) For sub-rules (1) and (2), the footage from an electronic enforcement device having electronic stamp for location, date and time, can be used to issue challan for the following offences, namely:—
 - (i) not driving within the prescribed speed limit (sections 112 and 183);
 - (ii) stopping or parking vehicle at an unauthorised location (section 122);
 - (iii) not undertaking Safety measures for drivers and pillion riders (section 128);
 - (iv) not wearing protective headgear or helmet (section 129);
 - (v) jumping a red light, violating a stop sign, using of handheld communications devices while driving, passing or overtaking other vehicles in a manner contrary to law, driving against the authorised flow of traffic, driving in any manner that falls far below what would be expected of a competent and careful driver and where it would be obvious to a competent and careful driver that driving in that manner would be dangerous (section 184);
 - (vi) driving vehicle exceeding permissible weight (sub-section (1) of section 194);
 - (vii) driving without safety belt (section 194B);
- (viii) contravention of rule 6 (pertaining to lane driving) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving) Regulations, 2017 (section 177A);
 - (ix) Goods carriage carrying passengers (section 66);
 - (x) contravention of rule 36 (pertaining to Registration plates) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving) Regulations, 2017 (section 177A);

- (xi) driving vehicle with load that extends beyond the sides of body or to the front or to the rear or in height beyond the permissible limit (sub-section (1A) of section 194);
- (xii) failure to provide free passage to emergency vehicle (section 194E).
- (4) (a) State Governments shall ensure that appropriate warning signs are conspicuously placed before the stretches monitored by electronic enforcement device, notifying the public that such device is in use and the concerned authorities shall ensure that physical markings, physical stop lines and pedestrian crossing are clearly marked on the road.
- (b) Appropriate fixed and dynamic speed limit signs may also be used to notify the speed limits on the road sections during adverse weather conditions, such as min, hail, foggy weather etc. as well as for indicating any obstruction ahead in the route.
- (5) (a) Body wearable cameras shall be explicitly used by the law enforcement officers, such as police and transport officials, while managing the traffic or carrying out any enforcement drive and such devices shall be used to record the proceedings of an event, which can be used in the court as an evidence against the offending driver or person and also ensure that the law enforcement official has acted as per the provisions of law while penalising the offending driver or person.
- (b) Both the video and audio functions of the body camera shall be activated only when the law enforcement official is on duty and the official shall notify the subjects that they are being recorded by the body camera.
- (6) All challans issued under rule 167 in electronic form using auto-generation of challan through the electronic monitoring and enforcement system shall be accompanied with the following information, namely:—
 - (i) clear photographic evidence highlighting the offence and the license plate of the vehicle;
 - (ii) measurement from the electronic enforcement device;
 - (iii) date, time and place of the offence;
 - (iv) notice specifying the provision of Act that has been violated;
 - (v) certificate as per sub-section(4) of section 65B of the Indian Evidence Act 1872(1 of 1872), which,-
 - (a) identifies the electronic record and describes the manner in which it was produced;
 - (b) gives such particulars of any device involved in the production of that electronic record as may be appropriate for the purpose of showing that the electronic record was produced by a computer,
 - (c) signed by the officer authorised in this behalf by the State Government.
- (7) Challans, under sub-rules (1) and (2), shall be issued in the name of the registered owner of the vehicle and must be accompanied with a notice of offence in electronic form viz SMS or e-mail or in physical form.
- (8) (a) The payment of the challan shall be made within the time period specified in the sub-rules (5), (6) and (7) of rule 167.
- (b) The payment of e-challan can be made electronically on an online portal specified by the State Government or using cash or card at Traffic Police Stations or at designated places or the e-payment gateway of the e-challan system as specified by States.
- (9) The notice of offence shall be sent within fifteen days of the occurrence of the offence and the electronic record collected by way of electronic monitoring should be stored till the disposal of challan and in the case where the electronic record relates to an offence, should be stored till the conclusion of proceedings initiated, including appeals.
- (10) In case the owner of the vehicle was not driving the vehicle at the time of offence, he may claim innocence before the police officer or any officer authorised by the State Government, by providing appropriate proof that he was not the driver at the time of the offence, or that another person was the driver at the time of the offence.".

G.S.R. 584[E).—Whereas the draft rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, were published, as required under sub-section (1) of section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), vide notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways number G.S.R. 53 (E), dated the 28th January, 2020 in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-II, section 3, sub-section (i) inviting objections and suggestions from affected persons before the expiry of the period of thirty days from the date on which copies of the Gazette containing the said notification were made available to public;

Whereas, copies of the said Gazette notification were made available to the public on the 28th January, 2020;

And whereas, the objections and suggestions received from the public in respect of the said draft rules have been considered by the Central Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 130, 198A, 210C, 211A and 215C of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, namely:—

- Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called as the Central Motor Vehicles (Eleventh Amendment) Rules, 2020.
 - (2) They shall come into force with effect from 1st October, 2020.
- 2. In the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (herein after referred as the said rules), in rule 2, -
 - (i) for clause (ca), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely -
 - "(ca) "Challan" means a document, in physical or electronic form issued by any police officer in uniform or any other officer authorised by the State Government in this behalf, to a person acting in violation of the provisions of the Act, in the form of a receipt comprising the details of the offence committed and the offender, the amount of penalty imposed and mode of collection of the same, if applicable, details of the officer issuing such document and other details as may be specified by the State Government;

Explanation: For the purposes of this clause, E-challan shall mean a challan issued in electronic form.

- (cb) "Combine Harvester" means an agricultural equipment vehicle, self propelled or agricultural tractor powered type (either coupled to the trailer for header assemble or any other attachment of machine) designed to perform more than one of the following tasks, namely: -
 - Picking, harvesting, threshing, separating, cleaning, chopping, collecting and unloading crop or agricultural produce, such as a grain, sugarcane, cotton, fodder, straw or stalk, while moving through the standing crop or agricultural produce;
 - (ii) Agreement of bagging with a pick-up attachment to use it for handling crop that has been swathed.
 - Explanation. For the purpose of these clause, a combine harvester shall be a non-transport motor vehicle, the driving on the road of which is incidental to the main intended use in the fields and for travelling from one field to another, for short durations, at a speed not exceeding thirty kilometer per hour."
- (ii) after clause (x), the following clause shall be inserted, namely: -
- "(xa) "Portal," means a web or electronic based system set up and maintained by the Central Government for-
 - (i) facilitating licensing, registration, issuance of certificate of fitness and permits of motor vehicles;
 - (ii) recording of offences including compounding, impounding, making endorsements, suspension and revocation of licenses and registrations;
 - (iii) issuance of e-challan;
 - (iv) preserving, retaining and granting access to machine readable, printable, shareable, verifiable and secure electronic records.".

- In the said rules, for rule 21, the following rule shall be substituted, namely. -3.
- "21. Powers of licencing authority to disqualify. (1) For the purpose of clause (f) of sub-section (1) of section 19 of the Act, the commission of the following acts by a holder of a driving licence shall constitute nuisance or danger to the public, namely: -
 - Theft of motor vehicle. (1)
 - Assault on passengers. (2)
 - Theft of personal effects of passengers. (3)
 - Theft of goods carried in goods carriages. (4)
 - Transport of goods prohibited under any law. (5)
 - Driver while driving a transport vehicle, engages himself in activity which is likely to disturb his (6) concentration.
 - Abduction of passengers-(7)
 - Carrying overload in goods carriages. (8)
 - Driving at speed exceeding the specified limit (9)
 - Carrying persons in goods carriage, either inside the driver's cabin in excess of its capacity or on the (10)vehicle, whether for hire or not.
 - Failing to comply with the provisions of section 134. (11)
 - Failure to stop when signalled to do so by any person authorised to do so.
 - Misbehaviour with and showing discourtesy to passengers, intending passengers or consignors and (12)(13)consignees of goods.
 - Smoking while driving public service vehicles. (14)
 - Abandoning vehicle in a public place causing inconvenience to other road users or to passengers in the (15)vehicle.
 - Driving vehicle while under the influence of drink or drugs.
 - Interfering with any person mounting or preparing to mount upon any other vehicle. (16)
 - Allowing any person to sit or placing things in such a way as to impede the driver from having a clear (17)vision of the road or proper control of the vehicle. (18)
 - Not stopping a stage carriage at approved stopping places for a sufficient period of time in a safe and convenient position upon demand or signal of the conductor or any passenger desiring to alight from the vehicle and unless there is no room in the vehicle, upon demand or signal of any person desiring to (19)becoming a passenger.
 - Loitering or unduly delaying any journey and not proceeding to the destination as near as may be in accordance with the time table pertaining to the vehicle, or, where there is no such time table, with all (20)
 - Not driving a contract carriage, in the absence of a reasonable cause, to the destination named by the (21)hirer by the shortest route.
 - The driver of a motor cab not accepting the first offer of hire which may be made to him irrespective of the length of the journey for which such offer is made. (22)
 - The driver of a motor cab demanding or extracting any fare in excess to that to which he is legally (23)entitled or refusing to ply motor cab.
 - Abandoning a transport vehicle as a mark of protest or agitation of any kind or strike in a public place or in any other place in a manner causing obstructions and inconvenience to the public or passengers or (24)other users of such places.
 - (2) Details of driving licences disqualified or revoked by the licensing authority shall be recorded chronologically in the portal and such record shall be reflected on a regular basis on the portal."
 - In the said rules, in rule 92, in sub-rule (2), after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely: -

- "(d) which is manufactured for the purposes of export including the movement of such vehicle by road from manufacturing plant to port of the export as well as any other location relevant for the purposes of facilitating such export, under the supervision of the vehicles manufacturer or dealer, as the case may be:".
- 5. In the said rules, for the rule 139, the following rule shall be substituted namely: -
- "139. Production of licence and certificate of registration.- (1) The driver or conductor of a motor vehicle shall produce certificates of registration, insurance, fitness and permit, the driving licence certificate for Pollution Under Check and any other relevant documents in physical or electronic form, as available on or downloaded from the portal, on demand by any police officer in uniform or any other officer, authorised by the State Government in this behalf, and if any or all of the documents are not in his possession, he shall produce in person an extract or extracts of the documents duly attested by any police officer or by any other officer or send it to the officer who demanded the documents by registered post within fifteen days from the date of demand.

Provided that after validation of the documents in electronic form, referred to in sub-rule (1), by any police officer in uniform or any other officer, authorised by the State Government in this behalf, if the information in documents are found to be valid and in force, then physical forms of such documents shall not be demanded for inspection, including in cases where there is an offence made out necessitating seizure of any such documents.

- (2) Upon demanding or inspecting any documents referred under sub-rule (1), the date and time stamp of inspection and identity of the police officer in uniform or any other officer authorised by the State Government, shall be recorded on the Portal.".
- In the said rules, after rule 139, the following rules shall be inserted, namely; -
- "139A. Seizure of documents produced in electronic form. (1) In cases where there is an offence made out necessitating seizure of any documents, and such documents are produced in electronic form in accordance with subrule (1) of rule 139(1), their seizure by any police officer or any other officer, authorised in this behalf shall be made electronically on the Portal.
- (2) Details of the seized documents shall be recorded chronologically in the relevant Portal and such record shall be reflected on a regular basis on the Portal.
- (3) Upon seizing any documents in accordance with sub-rule (1), the police officer in uniform or any other officer, authorised by the State Government shall issue a receipt acknowledging such seizure, in physical or electronic form.
- (4) Upon seizing any documents in accordance with sub-rule (1), the date and time stamp of seizure and identity of the police officer in uniform or any other officer authorised by the State Government, shall be recorded on the Portal.".
- 7. In the said rules, after rule 164, the following rules shall be inserted, namely: -
- "165. Use of handheld device. Use of handheld communications devices while driving shall solely be used for route navigation in such a manner that shall not disturb the concentration of the driver while driving.
- 166. Road Design, Construction and Maintenance Standards. (1) The design, construction and maintenance of national highways shall be in accordance with the standards and specifications of the Indian Road Congress as may be applicable, or any other instructions or guidelines issued by the Central Government from time to time.
- (2) The design, construction and maintenance of roads other than national highways shall be in accordance with the standards and specifications of the Indian Road Congress as may be applicable, or any other instructions or guidelines issued by the State Government from time to time.;
- (3) Subject to the previous approval of the Central Government or State Government, as the case may be, deviations from applicable standards, specifications, instructions and guidelines issued under sub-rule (1) or (2), may be made due to local conditions including but not limited to site constraints or built up area or land acquisition, and a copy of the said approval shall be annexed as part of the relevant contract.
- (4) The contract shall clearly define the terms designated authority, consultant and concessionaire.
- 167. Procedure for issuance and payment of challan: (1) Any police officer in uniform or any other officer, authorised by the State Government in this behalf shall issue a challan through system or e-challan facility physical or electronic form, to a person acting in violation of the provisions of the Act.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), in case of any person violates the provisions of the Act, the State Government or designated agency can enable auto-generation of challan through electronic monitoring and enforcement system or manually by any police officer or by a designated agency.

- (3) The challan issued under sub-rules (1) or (2), shall be delivered to a person who violates the provisions of the Act either by hand or any other physical or electronic means of communication authorised by the Central Government or State Government.
- (4) Details of challans issued under sub-rules (1) or (2), shall be recorded chronologically in the portal on a regular basis for access by enforcement officers.
- (5) Challans issued under sub-rules (1) or (2) shall be disposed of within ninety days from the date of issuance of the challan, in physical or electronic form, except in case of offences instituted for prosecution by a court.
- (6) If a challan is due beyond the time period specified in sub-rule (5), at least one additional notice for payment may be sent through electronic means of communication authorised by the Central Government or State Government or by way of call to the registered mobile number of a person who violates the provisions of the Act.
- (7) If a challan is due beyond the time period specified in sub-rule (5), except in case of offences instituted for prosecution by a court, then applications with respect to the license of offender or registration of motor vehicle, as the case may be, mentioned in the challan shall not be processed by the licensing authority or registering authority, as the case may be, except applications relating to permit, fitness and tax(es) of motor vehicle.
- (8) Subject to orders of the court, in respect of challans issued under sub rules (1) or (2), a police officer in uniform authorised by the State Government in this behalf may detain the vehicle involved in violation."
